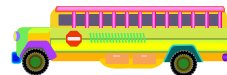

Uniform/Equipment Turn in:

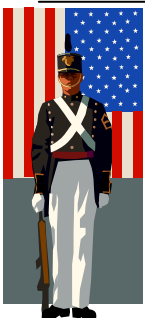
Students Athletes playing basketball or cheerleading are to turn in their uniforms to their coach.

HALLOWEEN COSTUME GUIDELINES:

From page 20 of the 2011-2012
Parent-Student Handbook:

Since All Hallows' Eve (Halloween) is the eve of All Saints Day, the costumes worn on All Hallows' Eve should be in keeping with the holiday.

1. Choose life-giving, positive types of costumes, such as religious or Bible figures, Disney characters, sports heroes, careers, harvest, toys, etc. Masks should be small and not cover the child's whole head.

2. If a student's costume is judged inappropriate, regular school clothes will have to be worn instead of the costume.

3. Kindergartners and Junior Kindergartners may wear their costumes to school. All other students must bring their costume to school to be put on just before the class party.

4. **NO** Costumes that depict or promote violence, war, blood, and death, swords, guns, weapons, and any type of object that depicts violence;

NO make-up, hair dye or hair spray, nail polish, etc. brought to school

NOTE: Parents that assist in classroom parties in costume must follow the above guidelines.
