ABOUT THE NATIONWIDE
EMERGENCY ALERT SYSTEM
TEST *NOVEMBER 9th**

As we get close to the nationwide test
of the Emergency Alert System, the
Federal Communications Commis-
sion (FCC) and all of our many part-
ners are working together to sp
read the word to as many members
of the public as possible -- so people
know what to expect when the test
takes place, and no one is caught off
guard.

Similar to local emergency alert sys-
tem tests, during the nationwide
test on November 9, an audio mes-
sage will interrupt television and radio
programming indicating: “This is a
test.” **The nationwide test will
last approximately *30 seconds_*
instead of 2-3 minutes, as originally
announced.*** *This change has been
made to reduce the disruption to the
American public, while still maintain-
ing our ability to test the
system’s nationwide capabilities.
