

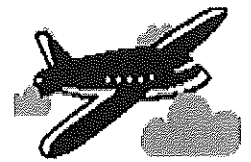

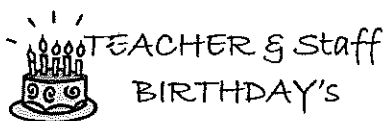
SUPERVISORS & SUBSTITUES NEEDED

SAVORY NOTES

Students, Parents and Staff I hope all of you have had a great beginning to our 2011 and 2012 school year. Please note the information below concerning Food Service.

Lunch tickets are sold on Monday or the first day of school for that week. Tickets are available to be purchased weekly, monthly, semester or yearly. You can also buy lunch daily for \$2.50. Lunch tickets do not carry over to the next year.

Monthly menu is provided in the last Jet Gazette of the month. Along with the 2 entrees listed daily we also offer a pizza choice.

Daily we have a salad bar that includes your choice of toppings for your salad and the choice of fresh or canned fruit. Every lunch comes with your choice of white, chocolate or strawberry milk.

Only after lunch is served an ala-carte line is available. Prices range from .25 cents to \$1.00. Choice include fresh fruit, healthy snacks baked and regular chips, muffins, string cheese, and our daily, home-made chocolate chip cookies.

On Friday or the last day of school for the week we have ice cream. For grades K-3 ice cream choices are .50 cents, grades 4-8 their choices range from .50 cents to \$1.00.
